Center Inima Lui, where are we?

While we were all still in Belgium, Marius was doing brisk work on the center. The superstructure was fully insulated and occupied, also the inside was repaired and prepared for finishing. All materials were bought for the entrance hall and preparations for it were made. Again it was so beautiful to see how the Lord is pulling the strings.

We met someone from a Romanian company dealing in insulation materials and paint of German manufacture. This was a Christian firm that gives extra discounts to charities. We got talking and the man immediately suggested that we make an offer for all the materials we needed to move forward. I agreed, thinking in the back of my mind "we don't have any money now anyway, but at least we will know exactly how much it will cost us. A few days later I received a message with the quote and just at that moment we received another donation, just enough for those materials. So they were ordered right away. A few days after that, our contractor came in, amazed at all the material that was delivered (because he knew the pennies were up). Surprised, he asked if this meant that he too could get back to work. We explained to him what had happened and said we were going to continue praying for more money. We needed as much as 7000€ for all the work hours and materials for the entrance and exterior finishing. Too bad, but we were stuck again for a while. But certainly not for long! Barely two days later we received word that someone from England had transferred exactly 7000€ for the next works. Wonderful right!?

Now we are again flat broke, we need another 10000€ to get everything finished, so we are looking forward to how the Lord will handle it. We are so looking forward to opening the center again.







And more paperwork for files from fire department

Once again we found that even more files need to be prepared. All invoices must be bundled and a quality report must be made of every bit of building material that was used. For this we need as many as three qualified people to help prepare this and to submit it to the authorities. Again a cost of no less than 2600€ to pay these persons.

Fortunately, two nice big donations unexpectedly came in again bringing us to this amount. The first inspections are already being carried out. Jessica has also started collecting the necessary documents from various families. In the coming period she will have to meet regularly with the social worker of the center to finalize all the files.

Shortly before we left for Belgium, we had another fantastic week with BMT (Belgian Mission Team). A whole week full of outreach and children's work. It was really great! Except for a few people, it was again a completely new group, but what a group. We thoroughly enjoyed one each individually, but certainly also as a group. Numerous touches, numerous beautiful moments, growth, prayer, encouragement, friendship/brotherhood, fun, deep impressions and all led by our loving Father. We are already looking forward to the next BMT group!
